The 12 coalitions in northeastern Minnesota were established as part of the *Minnesota Early Childhood Initiative... A Campaign for Our Youngest Children* which was created by the Northland Foundation and the five other <u>Minnesota Initiative Foundations</u> in 2003, in partnership with <u>The McKnight Foundation</u>. Since 2003, the Minnesota Initiative Foundations have developed a total of 90 coalitions throughout Greater Minnesota. This collaborative work has helped change the landscape of early care and education in our rural communities and statewide.
