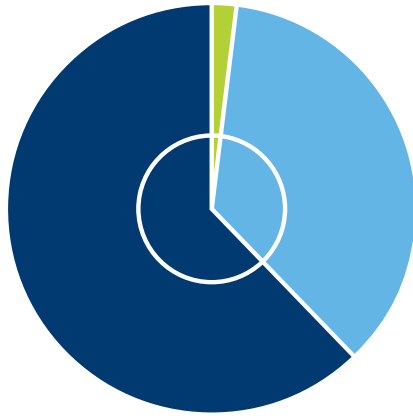


FUNDING SNAPSHOT

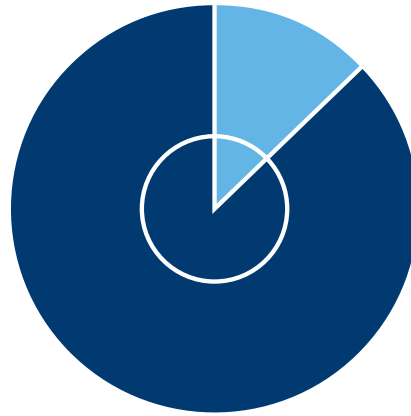

SOURCES OF FUNDS RAISED



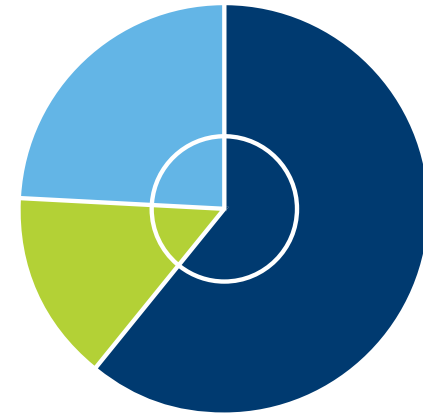
PRIVATE: 2%
