- 3. How does your project align with Maada'ookiing's grant focus areas? (5,000 character max.)
- 4. Which Tribal Nation or Indigenous community will this project serve? Please be specific about where the project will take place or have an impact and include any other community populations you will be working with, if applicable (gender, age, ability, LGBTQ+, etc.). (5,000 character max.)
- 5. Describe how you have gained the support of the communities you will be working with. How have you established trust or collaboration with them and how are you seeking the guidance and support of community and tribal leaders? (5,000 character max.)
- 6. Describe the needs or opportunities your project will focus on. (5,000 character max.)
- 7. Describe the activities you will carry out in this project. Include details like where the project will be held, the length of time the project will last, and any other information that will help us understand how you will be doing the work. (5,000 character max.)
- 8. What are your goals for this project and how will you measure the impact of your work on the community? (5,000 character max.)
